

LITTLE CHUTE CAREER PATHWAYS ACADEMY
WISCONSIN ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP RULE

In accordance with State Statute 39.11, scholarships will be offered to eligible students which exempt them from tuition and fees of post high school education at participating Wisconsin schools, and an amount equal to that charged at the University of Wisconsin-Madison at participating private schools. This includes public and private colleges and universities, and technical colleges. The scholarship may be maintained for up to four years when attending Bachelor Degree granting institutions, and up to three years when attending Associate Degree granting technical colleges.

Scholarship Criteria

- The Higher Educational Aids Board will award approximately \$2,250.00 per year to the student with the highest cumulative grade point average, and who will be attending a post-secondary institution in the State of Wisconsin.
- The number of recipients is determined by total enrollment, grades 9-12, as of third Friday in September.

If September enrollment was fewer than 80 students the Higher Educational Aids Board shall designate the 10 students, statewide from these high schools, with the highest GPAs as the recipients of the scholarship. Nominations are made by using the following criteria:

- The student with the highest GPA in all subjects who will be attending a Wisconsin college or university.
- The highest score and percentile ranking earned on the ACT, SAT, or other test required by the Wisconsin post secondary institution which the student intends to enroll.
- A letter, written by the student, indicating the reasons the student feels qualified for the AES and expressing intent to attend a participating post-secondary institution.

In the event of a tie, the Little Chute Career Pathways Academy will use the following criteria for identifying the recipient of the Wisconsin Academic Excellence Scholarship:

First Criteria:

*The student must be accepted and enrolled in a school within the State of Wisconsin.

Second Criteria:

*The student must have been in attendance for a minimum of two school calendar years at Little Chute Career Pathways Academy and completed all four levels.

Third Criteria:

*The student with the highest composite ACT score, through the 14th term, will be selected from the students who remain tied.

Fourth Criteria:

*An essay, the topic of which will be designated by the Little Chute Career Pathways Academy staff.
